\$1 MILLION TARGET 2011-12 BUDGET ADJUSTMENT

New Revenue

- \$5 per credit tuition increase, effective winter term ~\$133,000
- \$100,000 community support for Allied Heath/Nursing
- \$76,000 additional revenue (variety of sources)

Expenditure Reductions

- \$325,000 department reductions, salary savings, lower lease arrangements and efficiencies
- \$234,000 position reduction and reorganization
- \$70,000 savings from furlough days (2, 4 & 5 days)
- \$938,000 Total Estimated Adjustment
