

TOBACCO-FREE COLLEGE POLICY

Clatsop Community College is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its employees, students and visitors. Using guidance found in ORS 433.840, CCC will become a tobacco-free college. All college locations, campus-owned facilities, including extension centers, college-leased or rented buildings or properties, will be tobacco-free effective the start of the Fall 2018 academic term.

The college president will appoint a Tobacco-Free Implementation Team to promote the success of this policy. Membership may include representation from the Student Body, Faculty Association, Classified Staff Association, Adjunct Faculty Association, Service & Supervisory Members, Facilities, Neighbors of the College, Health Department Experts and a Cessation Specialist. With a goal of providing a safe and healthy environment, this committee will develop an implementation plan for this policy. This will include provisions for notification, signage, fines, disciplinary consequences, complaint procedures, and enforcement.

Effective immediately any individual under 21 years of age is prohibited from possessing tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems while on College premises.

Applications for exceptions to this policy may be sought for Native American ceremonial practices by contacting the Office of the President.
