The purpose of the **Healthcare Diversity Scholarship** shall be to provide financial assistance for Clatsop Community College students pursuing a certificate or degree related to healthcare.

Scholarship Amount:

\$1,000 each for ten scholarships, renewable each term, up to \$2,000. Eight to be awarded for Fall, Winter, Spring terms and two to be awarded for Summer term.

Scholarship Criteria:

Criteria for application and award:

- Applications are available for students who are enrolled in a healthcare related certificate or degree program, including emergency medical technician, medical assistant, nursing, or certified nursing assistant and other healthcare related degrees and programs.
- Minimum 2.0 GPA required at the time of application and each term that the scholarship is in effect.
- Participation in both campus and community activities.
- Minimum of six credits during each term the scholarship is in effect.
- Preference will be given to students from underrepresented racial and/or ethnic minorities.
- Preference will be given to bilingual students
- Preference will be given to first generation college students.
- Applicants will be selected by a committee comprised of DEI Council Committee members, and/or DEI Council Committee selected members.
- The student may use scholarship funds for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or any educational expense. Recipient may receive cash back after educational expenses have been paid.
- Funds will be disbursed to recipients at the beginning of the respective term in which they applied.



Scholarship Timeline:

Fall Term: Scholarship to be announced by Office of Financial Aid at the beginning of fall term, to be awarded during the first two weeks of fall term. Applicants will be screened by the Office of Financial Aid and referred to the DEI Council Committee to select the winners. Winners will be announced by the DEI Council Committee. Allotment will be disbursed to recipients upon completion of enrollment and verification of requisite GPA.

Winter Term: Scholarship to be announced by Office of Financial Aid during Fall term, to be awarded during the first two weeks of winter term. Applicants will be screened by the Office of Financial Aid and referred to the DEI Council Committee to select the winners. Winners will be announced by the DEI Council Committee. Allotment will be disbursed to recipients upon completion of enrollment and verification of requisite GPA.

Spring Term: Scholarship to be announced by Office of Financial Aid during Winter term, to be awarded during the first two weeks of Spring term. Applicants will be screened by the Office of Financial Aid and referred to the DEI Council Committee to select the winners. Winners will be announced by the DEI Council Committee. Allotment will be disbursed to recipients upon completion of enrollment and verification of requisite GPA.

Summer Term: Scholarship to be announced by Office of Financial Aid during Winter term, to be awarded during the first two weeks of Spring term. Applicants will be screened by the Office of Financial Aid and referred to the DEI Council Committee to select the winners. Winners will be announced by the DEI Council Committee. Allotment will be disbursed to recipients upon completion of enrollment and verification of requisite GPA.
