

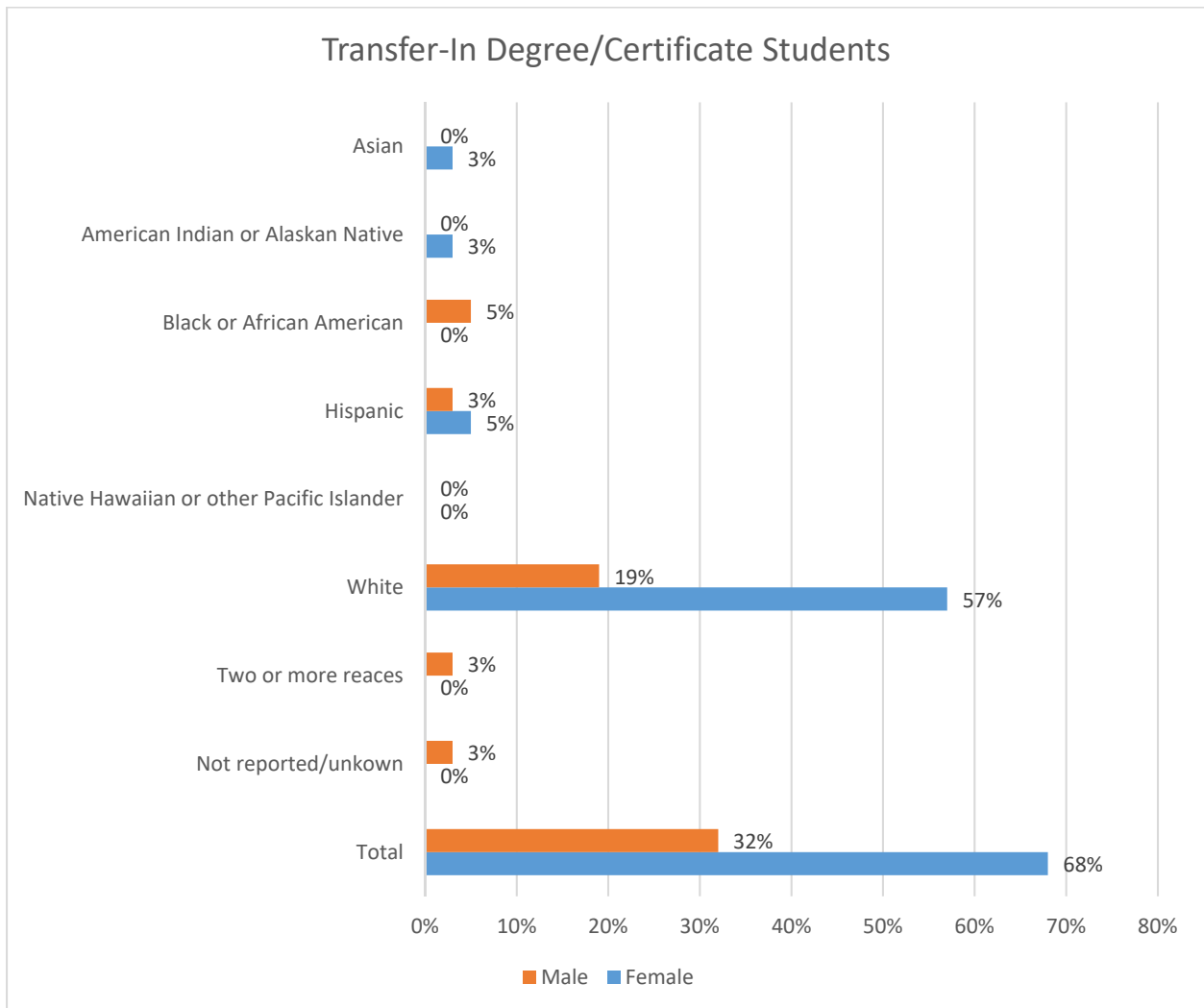
Transfer-In Demographics for Fall 2016-17 Cohort Race, Ethnicity, and Gender
