INTRO TO ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING

Electronics are at the center of the modern world. Take the first leap toward creating your own as we learn the basic principles of circuit design, from simple passive components to more advanced devices, such as motors, transistors, logic gates, LEDs, Arduinos, sensors, and more!

3D GAME DESIGN: GAME CREATION

Build your own video game! Using easy-to-learn, industry-standard software, we'll explore the basics of video game design. In class, each student will develop their own playable game and leave with the skills and tools to continue expanding their project.

INTRO TO COMPUTER VISION

Computer Vision is the art of teaching machines not just to see the world around them, but to understand it. This art is essential to the robots, smartphones, and vehicles of tomorrow. In this class, we'll learn the basics of computer vision. These skills will be taught using Python and a Pi Camera on the Raspberry Pi platform. Students will walk away with an understanding of the basic techniques of computer vision and a viable testing platform for future ideas!

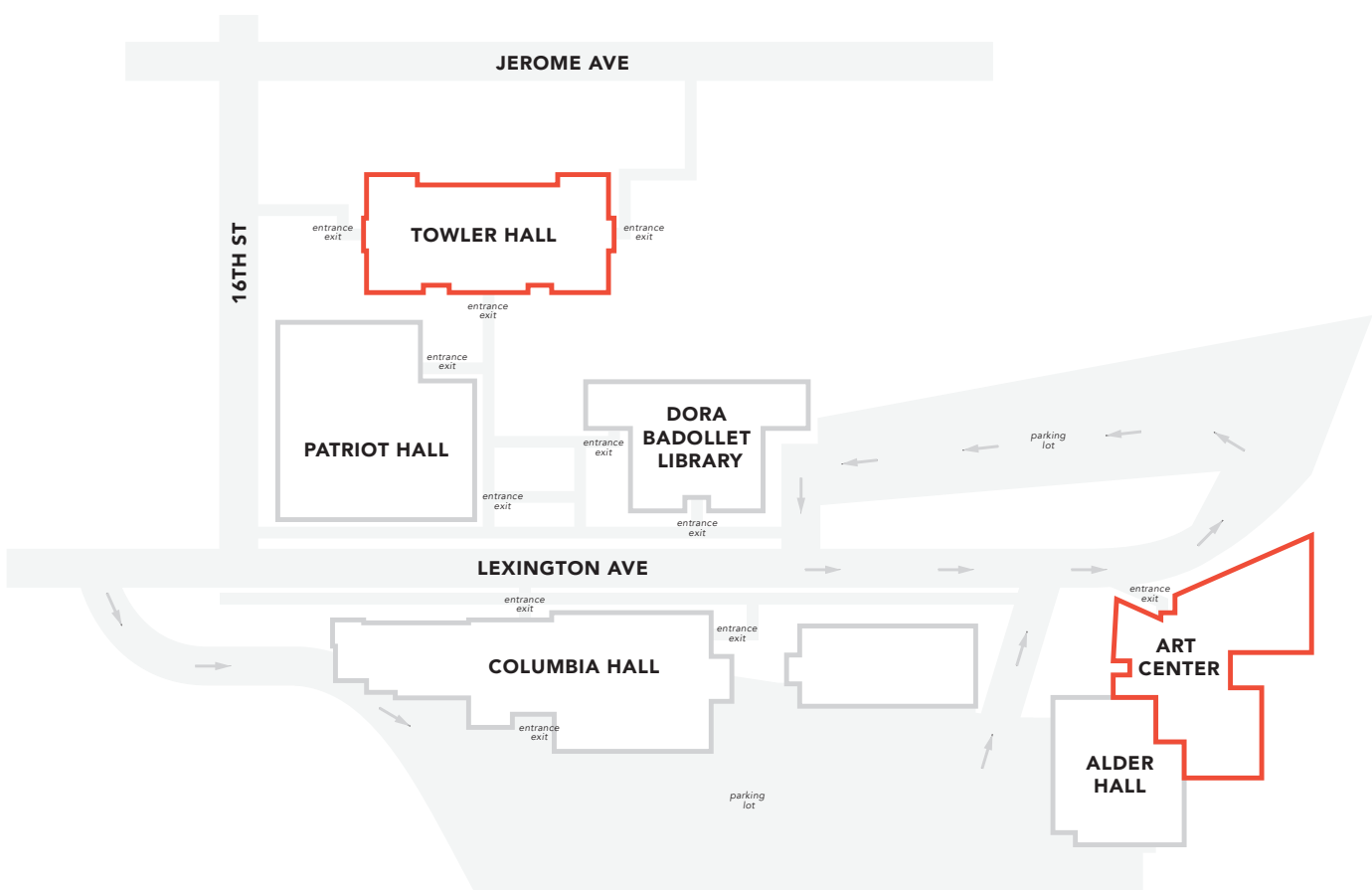
