The President shall ensure that the College has and implements a continuous, broad-based comprehensive, systematic, and integrated system of planning that involves appropriate segments of the college community, is designed to support and further the College's mission, with a focus on student learning and success. This model sets the foundation for regular and effective assessment supported by institutional effectiveness research providing the College with opportunities for improvement, accomplishment and adaptation

The planning system include plans required by law, including, but not limited to:

- Enrollment Management
- Advising & Retention
- Academic Master Plan
- Fiscal Management (includes Budget & Audit)
- Facilities Master Plan
- Technology Plan
- Emergency Preparedness Plan

The President shall submit those plans for which Board of Education approval is required to the Board of Education.

The President shall inform the Board of Education about the status of planning and the various plans.

The President shall ensure the Board of Education has an opportunity to assist in developing the general institutional mission and goals for the comprehensive plans.
