

**Procedures for
Student Health Screening and Immunization**

Students enrolling in: the Nursing Program, Medical Assistant practicum courses (MA 133, Medical Assistant Clinical Practicum 1 and MA 231, Medical Assistant Clinical Practicum 2) ; EMT Basic (EMT 151 and EMT 152); and EMT Intermediate (EMT 165 and EMT 166) shall provide the Director of Health Occupations documentation of the following:

- (1) Written documentation of two doses of measles vaccine on or after 1st birthday, plus one dose of mumps vaccine and one dose of rubella vaccine OR Laboratory evidence of immunity (a positive titer for measles, mumps, and rubella antibody). Students born prior to January 1, 1957 are exempt from this requirement.
- (2) Written documentation of completion of Hepatitis B series or declination statement, OR laboratory evidence of Hepatitis B immunity
- (3) Written documentation of a 2-step negative tuberculin skin test (Mantoux) or a Quantiferon Gold test within the past year OR if Tb test is positive, written documentation of negative chest x-ray and Negative Symptom Review in the past year.
- (4) Proof of disease OR written documentation of Varicella vaccine OR laboratory evidence of immunity (a positive Varicella titer).
- (5) Written documentation of current tetanus and diphtheria immunization.

Students enrolling in Cooperative Work Experience: Education (ED280) or Cooperative Work Experience: Early Childhood Education (ECE 280) shall provide the Director of Cooperative Work Experience with written documentation of two doses of measles vaccine on or after 1st birthday, plus one dose of mumps vaccine and one dose of rubella vaccine OR laboratory evidence of immunity (a positive titer for measles, mumps, and rubella antibody). Students born prior to January 1, 1957 are exempt from this requirement.

Students who are members of intercollegiate sports teams shall provide the Registrar with written documentation of two doses of measles vaccine on or after 1st birthday, plus one dose of mumps vaccine and one dose of rubella vaccine OR laboratory evidence of immunity (a positive titer for measles, mumps, and rubella antibody). Students born prior to January 1, 1957 are exempt from this requirement.

Records of required immunizations and screenings will be made a permanent part of the student's college record retained in accordance with state and federal records laws/rules.
