Evaluative symbols:

- A – Excellent
- B – Commendable
- C – Satisfactory
- D – Minimal (Less than satisfactory)
- F – Unacceptable
- P – Pass (At least satisfactory)
- NP – No Pass (Less than satisfactory)

Non-Evaluative symbols:

- I – Incomplete (student has satisfactorily completed 70% of the course work)
- W – Withdrawal AU – Audit
- NG – No Grade

NG, I and AU are not used to compute GPA.

Degree or certificate requirements may only allow specific grade system options.
