

Provide one of the following documents that indicates your high school completion status prior to when you will begin college in 2020–2021:

- A copy of your high school diploma.
- A copy of your final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- A copy of your General Educational Development (GED) certificate or GED transcript.
- An academic transcript that indicates you successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- A homeschool transcript or the equivalent, signed by your parent or guardian, which lists the secondary school courses you completed and documents the successful completion of a secondary school education in a homeschool setting. (If state law does not require a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), such as in Oregon.)

Your aid eligibility may be grandfathered in if, prior to July 1, 2012, you had an academic transcript showing prior enrollment and one of the following:

- Placement exam scores that met ability-to-benefit minimums, or
- You completed at least six credits that apply toward an aid-eligible certification or degree program (if not from CCC, must be certified by your prior college).
