



**Request to Decline  
Federal PELL Grant Funds  
2020-2021**

Disclosure: Per the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2012, lifetime eligibility for a federal Pell grant is limited to six full-time equivalent years (18 quarters/12 semesters), or 600%, toward an undergraduate degree. Usage dates back to 1972 as reported by the federal Common Origination and Disbursement system.

You may decline a term disbursement of a Pell Grant that you are otherwise eligible to receive.

However, before you decline funding, you need to understand the following:

- 1) If you plan to receive financial aid at any point in the future, you are still responsible for maintaining the Satisfactory Academic Progress guidelines associated with financial aid. - 2) To decline is completely voluntary.
