Charge

The Strategic Enrollment Management Committee will develop a holistic and integrated approach to enrollment management that supports college-wide collaboration, engagement, creative-thinking and consensus building.

The purpose of the Strategic Enrollment Management Committee is to discuss enrollment strategies and to make recommendations that contribute to sustainable student access, recruitment, persistence, completion, and lifelong learning through diverse program offerings.

Committee Responsibilities:

- Evaluate on-going enrollment trends, activities, and initiatives within the college and the community.
- Evaluate college practices that impact recruitment, retention, and completion, including new student recruitment and onboarding, class scheduling, registration, financial aid, and advising.
- Use high-quality qualitative and quantitative data to inform recommendations
- Collaborate with college constituencies to develop, implement, and evaluate enrollment management goals and strategies that align with the college's Strategic Plan.
- Assess, evaluate, and make recommendations for strategies to enhance student access, success, persistence, and goal attainment
- Monitor and evaluate progress toward strategic enrollment planning goals
- Develop intentional marketing strategies to prospective and current students unique to the college's student population and community


