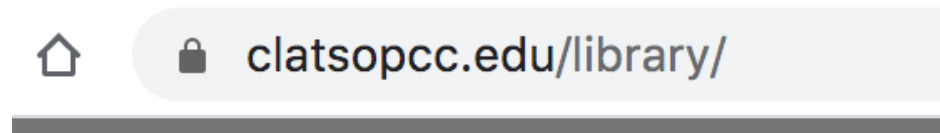


Using the Library Databases

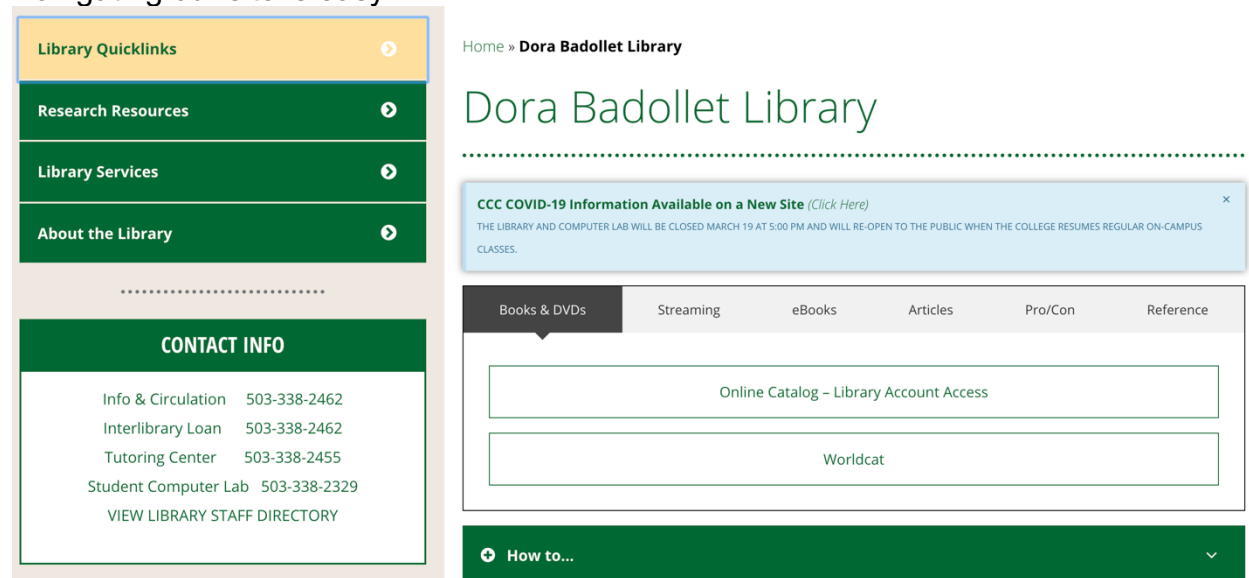

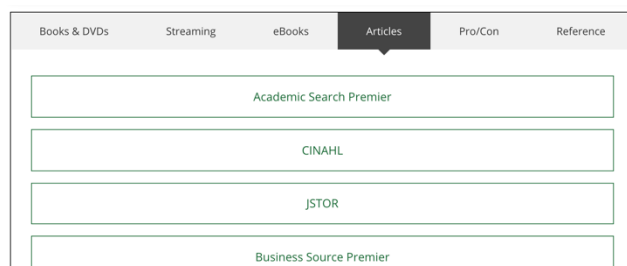

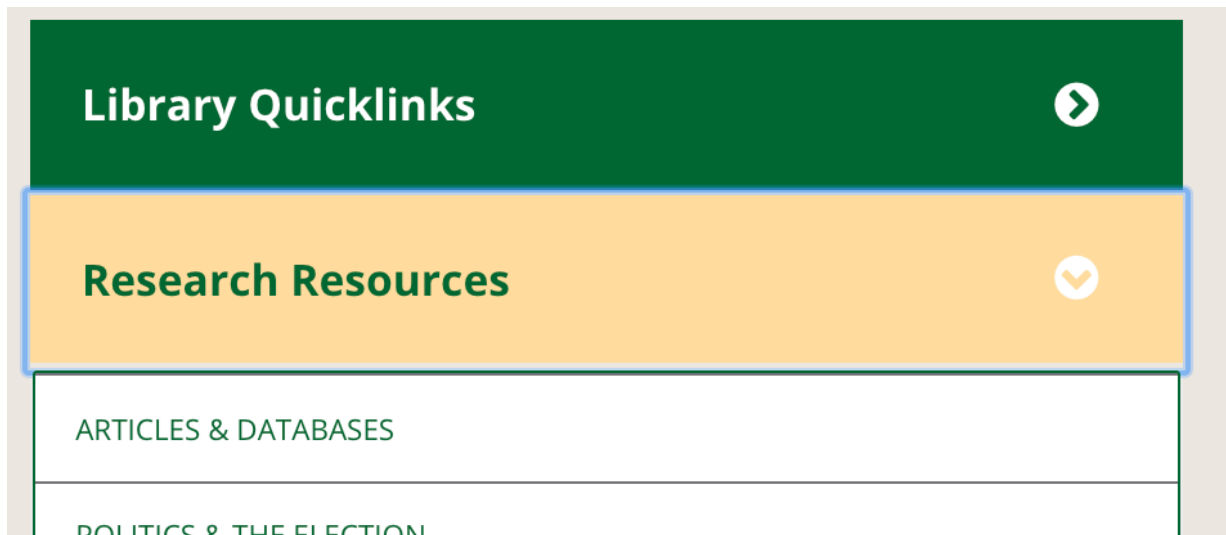
Navigating our site is easy.



On the righthand side, you'll find the main search area, with tabs for Books & DVDs, Streaming, eBooks, Articles, Pro/Con and Reference. The selection defaults to the Books and DVDs search. If you select the Articles tab, you have access to some of our article databases.

Academic OneFile [GALE]

Academic OneFile is a starting point for peer-reviewed, full-text articles from the world's leading journals and reference sources. Covering the physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, the arts, theology, literature, and other subjects, it contains millions of articles available in full-text. Includes full-text New York Times content from 1995 to present.

Academic Search Premier [EBSCO]

(EBSCO) - a multi-disciplinary database that provides full text for more than 4,600 journals, including full text for nearly 3,900 peer-reviewed titles. PDF backfiles to 1975 or further are available for well over one hundred journals, and searchable cited references are provided for more than 1,000 titles.

When you click the database link from off campus, you'll be prompted to authenticate for the session using your email log-in credentials. If you are on campus, you will go straight to the resource.

For remote access, you'll need to log in using your student credentials. Your username is first Initial, last name, last four digits of student ID#, and @students.clatsopcc.edu (example: bsmith5453@students.clatsopcc.edu). Your password format is A@YYYYMMDD (birthdate year, month, day; example: A@20010413).

Once inside the resource—in this case, Academic Search Premier—you can search for articles or other information sources.

ABSTRACT

Objective: Currently, there are limited comparative data concerning long-term major clinical outcomes following the angiotensin-converting-enzyme inhibitors (ACEIs) and angiotensin II type 1 (AT1) receptor blockers (ARBs) therapy in patients with acute myocardial infarction (AMI) with dyslipidemia after a successful stent implantation. Therefore, we investigated major clinical outcomes for 2 years following the ACEIs and ARBs therapy in these patients.

Methods: A total of 3015 patients with AMI who underwent a successful stent implantation and were prescribed ACEIs (n=2175) or ARBs (n=840)

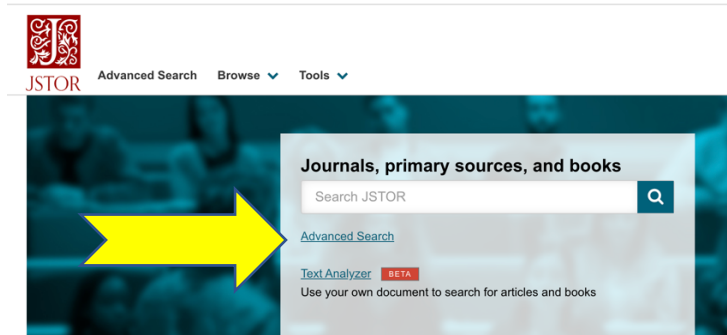
