2020 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET

Warrenton High School Scholarships, Inc. was founded on May 12, 1994 for the “sole purpose” of providing scholarships to graduates of Warrenton High School. Over \$2,020,265.00 has been awarded to over 500 Warrenton graduates since the creation of Scholarships, Inc. to help students continue their education.

Eligibility

To be considered for a scholarship, a student:

1. Must be a Warrenton High School senior.
2. Must have a minimum GPA of not less than 2.0 – NOTE: some scholarships require higher GPAs.
3. Must represent responsible citizenship, including digital citizenship. Applicants having engaged in known illegal activity, bullying or questionable social media activity may not be considered.
4. Must have made specific plans for education beyond high school consistent with educational goals.
5. Must plan to attend an accredited or licensed educational/professional/technical institution as a full-time student.
6. Must be willing to be interviewed by the selection committee.

Application Packet

To apply for a scholarship, you must submit all information requested in this packet, including (in this order):

1. A cover sheet that includes your full name and a recent picture
2. The completed General Information sheet (page 7 of this packet)
3. A current copy of your high school transcript after 7 semesters.
4. The Scholarships Applying for Checklist (page 8 of this packet)
5. An essay presenting your specific educational goals beyond high school and how you plan to finance your education. Include how this scholarship will assist you with your academic endeavors and how this scholarship would help you reach those goals. This essay should be no more than two pages.
6. An essay on any topic you choose. Some ideas you might consider include a special talent or unusual interest that sets you apart from your peers or a significant experience that influenced your life. Tell us something we don't know from your application. This essay should be no more than two pages.
7. Additional essays required for certain scholarships offered within this packet must be titled with the specific scholarship and included in the packet.
8. Remaining documents: letters of acceptances from colleges, list of activities, etc. **DO NOT PROVIDE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS or FAMILY INCOME INFORMATION.**

Student Check List

In addition to the above submitted documents, you must obtain three completed recommendations (teacher, advisor, other community member) that will be added to the application packet by WHS office personnel. Recommendation Forms are available in the Senior File at WHS.

- You need to plan ahead when requesting recommendations. Please give the people from whom you are requesting a recommendation at least two weeks to complete the form and return it to the office.
- Recommendation forms are to be returned directly to the WHS office by the person completing the form (due to confidentiality). They are not to be included in the application packet you submit.**
- It is your responsibility to insure that the recommendations have been returned to the WHS Office on or before 3:00 on Friday, April 3, 2020.**

General information relating to the application packet

- Only candidates with completed applications, submitted by the due date will be invited to interview.
- Please be aware that there is competition for all scholarships. Applying and interviewing for a scholarship is not a guarantee that a scholarship will be awarded to you.
- All submitted documents must be typed or computer generated and must be double-spaced using Times New Roman, 12-point font.
- Twenty double-sided copies of your application package, including all documents listed above, must be **submitted to the WHS Office on or before 3:00 on Friday, April 3, 2020.**
No folders or slip covers allowed.
- Interviews will take place on Friday, April 17, 2020. You are required to dress appropriately.

Scholarship Applicant Good Standing Considerations**

Scholarship Applicants for Scholarships Funded and Awarded by the WHSSI Board

Students applying for scholarships from funds raised by and awarded by the WHSSI board are expected to be students in good standing with a cumulative grade point average of not less than 2.0 and who generally represent good citizenship through contributions of positive school and community activity.

Applicant having engaged in known illegal activity, questionable social media postings, bullying or activities that are inconsistent with responsible citizenship or positive representation of a Warrenton High School student in good standing may not be considered.

Scholarship Applicants for Scholarships Funded by Others and Awarded by the WHSSI Board

Students applying for scholarships funded by others and awarded by the WHSSI board are expected meet the minimum requirements for the scholarship being applied for. In addition to the specific requirements, the WHSSI board is implementing a standard that applicants must generally represent good citizenship through contributions of positive school activity.

Applicant having engaged in known illegal activity, questionable social media postings, bullying or activities that are inconsistent with responsible citizenship or positive representation of a Warrenton High School student in good standing may not be considered.

DONNIE ADAMS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Donnie Adams, selected by the Adams Family

Considerations for community involvement, school involvement, college/career plans.

(No GPA requirement)

SANDY ADAMS SOFTBALL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Sandy Adams, selected by Walt Ferguson

The recipient will be the graduating senior with the highest cumulative GPA, who was an active member of the junior varsity of varsity softball team in good standing for three or more years, and who has earned and received a varsity letter for WHS softball during two or more years. Enrollment as a student in an accredited two year or four year college, university or vocational school in the United States is acceptable.

TED ANTILLA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Ted Antilla, selected by the Antilla Family

This scholarship was established in 2015. The general eligibility criteria of the scholarship application apply.

ASTORIA CLOWNS SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of the Astoria Clowns, selected by the Scholarships, Inc. Committee

This award was established in 1999 in memory of Jimmy Welch. The recipient must attend Clatsop Community College on a full-time basis. He or she must have some community and school involvement. There is no GPA requirement.

BRUCE & BEVERLY BOBEK SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of Angel Medical, selected by the Scholarships, Inc. Committee

This scholarship was established in 2000. The general eligibility criteria of the scholarship application apply.

MASONIC LODGE #175 SCHOLARSHIP – Four-year Scholarship – Scholarship amount varies

Awarded on behalf of the Gateway Masonic Lodge #175 and is selected by the board of directors of the scholarship fund of the Gateway Masonic Lodge.

Dick and Harriet Baldwin established these scholarships through a bequest. They were teachers at WHS and it was their desire to help graduates of Warrenton High School further their education. Recipients must have attained a GPA of 3.0 or better, excelled in citizenship, participated in school activities, been involved in community service, and displayed good leadership qualities. These scholarships may be used at any accredited two or four year institutions of higher learning and are not limited to colleges and universities in the state of Oregon. To renew a scholarship, the recipient must present evidence that he/she has been a full-time student and has maintained a GPA of at least 2.5.

BAYSHORE ANIMAL HOSPITAL - \$1,000 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of the Bayshore Animal Hospital, selected by Bayshore Animal Hospital

This scholarship, established in 2002, is available to a senior seeking a career in veterinary medicine or any animal related field. **The application must include a 1000 word essay answering the question; “How will my education benefit the welfare of animals?”** The award may be used at any four-year degree institution, two-year community college, or vocational school of the recipient’s choice as a full time student. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required.

BioOREGON PROTEIN INC. SCHOLARSHIP - \$1,200 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of BioProtein, Inc., selected by the Scholarships, Inc. Committee

The general eligibility criteria of the scholarship application apply.

DORIS BULLETSSET MEMORIAL - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Doris Bulletsset, selected by Scholarships, Inc. Committee
Student must be planning on attending Clatsop Community College.

COASTAL FAMILY HEALTH CENTER – Boy/\$500 Girl/\$500 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of Coastal Family Health Center, selected by the Scholarships, Inc. Committee

Graduates must be entering a post-secondary health related field. Special consideration may be given to student who possesses the following: GPA of 2.75 or higher, a sense of community involvement and be community driven, and financial need.

BARB AND JEAN CAMP MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Barb & Jean Camp, selected by the Scholarships, Inc. Committee

Seniors may apply for this scholarship. No minimum GPA requirement. The main criteria are good character, pleasant personality and school spirit. Student must be enthusiastic about school and representing it. This award may be used at any four-year degree granting institution or two-year community college of the recipient's choice.

DEBBIE DUNN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$2000 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Debbie Dunn, selected by Scholarships, Inc. Committee

This scholarship was established in 1977 in Debbie's memory. A senior with a minimum GPA of 2.0 may apply and renew that application again the following year. The award may be used at any four-year institution, two-year community college, or vocational school of the recipient's choice.

KEITH DYER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Keith Dyer, selected by the Dyer family

This scholarship was established in 2006 in memory of Keith Dyer, a community and school leader, this scholarship will be selected by the Dyer Family. There are no specific criteria for this scholarship.

DR. LEINASSAR HEALTH SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIP - \$300 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of Dr. Leinassar, selected by selected by Scholarships, Inc. Committee

This scholarship was established 1994 to provide financial assistance to worthy graduates who wish to continue their formal education in the sciences with a special interest in the healing arts. Financial need is not a determining factor in selecting a winner of this scholarship. Applicants must have made specific plans for majoring in the sciences or healing arts.

LUM'S AUTO CENTER SCHOLARSHIP – Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of Lum's Auto Center, selected by Lum's Auto Center

This award was established in 2013. This scholarship is intended to provide to students who have excelled academically, made a difference in the community and are role models of good citizenship and leadership. The recipient must be a graduating senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Lum's Auto Center will award two scholarships. The student need not attend a four-year school, but must be working toward a four-year degree at an accredited institution. Lum's is committed to making our community a better place for all of us.

DICK MATTSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Dick Mattson, selected by Scholarships, Inc. Committee

This scholarship was established in 2018 in memory of Dick Mattson. This scholarship will be awarded to one boy and one girl who are graduating from WHS. Scholarships will be awarded to individuals who have demonstrated good character and a strong work ethic. There is no GPA requirement.

RE/MAX RIVER & SEA/ SEASIDE TEMPS – Two-year Scholarship-\$1000 each year

Awarded on behalf of RE/MAX River & Sea/ Seaside Temps, selected by Dave & Trina Hoggard

A senior with a minimum GPA of 2.0 and will be entering the trades (nursing, mechanic, plumber, electrician, welder, carpenter and such), may apply and renew that application again the following year. The award may be used at any four-year institution, two-year community college, or vocational school of the recipient's choice.

KELLY SMOTHERMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Kelly Smotherman, selected by Madison and Chelsea Smotherman

This scholarship was established 2016 when Kelly Smotherman, Warrenton graduate, and a contributing member of the community passed away. Kelly was a hardworking man that dedicated his life to fishing and his girls. This Scholarship is intended for an individual that has experienced a time in their life where they had to persevere through a hard time. *The application must include an essay on perseverance.* The award may be used for a 4-year university, community college, or vocational school. There is no GPA requirement.

JARROD THEBIAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$1000 Scholarship

Awarded in memory of Jarrod Thebiay, selected by the Thebiay Family

This scholarship was created in 2002 in memory of Jarrod Thebiay. The recipient must be out-going, pleasant and have participated in sports for at least one year. There is a 2.5 GPA requirement. Financial need is not a determining factor in selecting a winner of this scholarship. The award may be used at any four-year degree institution, two-year community college, vocational school or accredited apprentice program of the recipient's choice as a full-time student. The Thebiay Family will select the student to whom this scholarship will be awarded.

WARRENTON MINI-MART SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of the Warrenton Mini-Mart, selected by Don Patterson

The general eligibility criteria of the scholarship application apply and Mr. Patterson says he "has to like you".

WARRENTON VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER'S ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS – Scholarship amounts vary

Awarded on behalf of the Warrenton Volunteer Firefighter's Association, selected by the Firefighter's Association

These grants will be awarded to two seniors with minimum GPAs of 2.5. Applicants must be in the fire science or medical field to apply. The award may be used at any Oregon four-year degree institution, two-year community college, or vocational school of the recipient's choice as a full-time student. The Warrenton Volunteer Firefighter's Association will select the recipient.

WARRENTON HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS, INC. – Scholarship amounts vary

Awarded on behalf of Warrenton Scholarships, Inc., selected by the Scholarships, Inc. Committee

These scholarships were established in the spring of 1994. This foundation was the first non-profit corporation scholarship program for Warrenton High School. Designed to attract and recognize outstanding students who have demonstrated high academic achievement (minimum GPA 2.0), service to school and community, and leadership qualities, and who wish to continue their formal education. Recipients are also encouraged to contribute to the scholarship fund in the future.

WARRENTON HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS, INC. FOR CLATSOP CC - \$1,000 Scholarship

Awarded on behalf of Warrenton Scholarships, Inc., selected by the Scholarships, Inc. Committee

Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5. Preference is given to students with a Junior/Senior year GPA of at least 2.5. **With your application, an additional 250 word response titled, "Why I want to go the Clatsop Community College."** Scholarship receipt must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 credit hours per quarter at Clatsop Community College.

PAT & LYNDA RYAN SCHOLARSHIP – Two \$1000 Scholarships – one boy and one girl

Awarded on behalf of Pat & Lynda Ryan, selected by the Scholarship Inc. Committee

This scholarship was established in 2019. The general eligibility criteria of the scholarship application apply.

MULTICULTURAL CLUB SCHOLARSHIP – Two \$250.00 Scholarships

Awarded on behalf of Warrenton High School Multicultural Club, selected by Alejandra Lopez and Dan Stein

Students must be active in the Multicultural Club with a minimum GPA of 2.5. Scholarship can be used for College or Trade School. Applicants will submit a 100 word Essay and be interviewed by Alejandra Lopez and Dan Stein.
