Ed served as a welding instructor at CCC from 1976 –2001. Ed had a passion for welding and creating artistic pieces. In addition to creating sculptures and metal work, Ed was an artist who enjoyed drawing and painting. He was generous to bequeath the majority of his estate to the CCC Foundation to establish an endowed scholarship to support welding students and also provide a program support fund in the amount of \$46,000.

Ed's legacy and impact will continue indefinitely through his scholarship fund and the CCC welding student recipients.
