The establishment of a Health and Safety Committee is required by state and Federal workplace safety laws. The purpose of the Health and Safety Committee is to promote safety in the workplace through cooperative efforts of a cross section of the campus community.

Duties of the Health and Safety Committee are consistent with those outlined in OAR 437-001-0765.

Health and Safety Committee Membership

Membership on the committee is voluntary. Members will actively seek representation from all campus constituent groups: Classified, faculty, and service/supervisory. Efforts will also be made to include membership from each college campus or area. The Director of Physical Plant and the Director of Human Resources will serve on the committee as non-voting resources.

One member of the committee will be elected the Chairperson for a one-year term. Another member of the committee will serve as recording secretary. Minutes and agendas of meetings will be posted for review by all employees.
