AP 2431 Selection of the President

The Board of Education is the ultimate decision-maker in those areas assigned to it by state and federal laws and regulations. In executing that responsibility, the Board of Education is committed to its obligation to ensure that appropriate members of the College participate in developing recommended policies for Board of Education action and administrative procedures for Presidential action under which the Clatsop Community College is governed and administered.

Each of the following shall participate in the decision-making processes of the College:

- College employees provide input to development of relevant policies and procedures
- Associated Student Government provide input to, review, and approve student-related policies and procedures
- President's Cabinet provide input to, review, and approve policies and procedures
- College Council provide input to, review, and approve policies and procedures
- DEI Council provide input to, review, and approve policies and procedures

Except for unforeseeable emergency situations, the Board of Education shall not take any action on matters subject to this policy until the appropriate constituent group or groups have been provided the opportunity to participate.

Any duty imposed upon the Board of Education as a body shall be performed at a regular or special meeting and shall be made a matter of record. The consent to any particular measure obtained from individual Board of Education members when the Board of Education is not in session shall not be an act of the Board of Education and shall not be binding upon the district.
