All academic and clinical requirements listed below are required by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). Testing for math and writing proficiency is available at CCC by appointment. All other documentation will be uploaded to Castle Branch within 90 days of the start of EMT 151.

**MATH PROFICIENCY: Applicants must demonstrate:**

- ALEKS PPL numerical test score of **15**  
OR Accuplacer score of **26** or higher,  
OR Accuplacer Next-Gen score of **233** or higher.  
OR Completion of MTH 060 or higher with a grade of C or higher (on a college transcript)

**WRITING PROFICIENCY: Applicants must demonstrate:**

- Accuplacer score of **95** or higher,  
OR Accuplacer Next-Gen score of **241** or higher.  
OR Completion of WR 115 or higher with a grade of C or higher (on a college transcript)

**VALID PHOTO ID/DRIVER'S LICENSE:**

- Applicants must provide a copy of a valid government-issued photo ID or driver's license that includes a date of birth. Students must be 18 years of age or older by the date of course completion (March 2027).

**HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA/GED CERTIFICATE:**

- Applicants must provide a high school diploma or a GED certificate.

**DRUG SCREENING:**

- Applicants must complete a **10-Panel Drug Screen** for amphetamines (including methamphetamines & MDMA), barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cocaine, marijuana, methadone, opiates, phencyclidine, and propoxyphene. Testing will be completed within 90 days of the start of EMT 151.

**BACKGROUND CHECK:**

- Applicants must pass a **State/National Criminal Background Check** within 90 days of the start of EMT 151.

**IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS:** All students will be required to provide proof of the following **immunizations and/or immunity titers:**

- Negative TB test results within the previous 12 months or negative QuantiFERON results
- TDAP vaccine
- Varicella vaccine
- MMR vaccine (not required if born before 1956)
- Hepatitis B vaccine (3 doses): a minimum of two doses must be completed before class begins  
2<sup>nd</sup> dose can be given 30 days after 1<sup>st</sup> dose; 3<sup>rd</sup> dose is administered 3-6 months after 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

**CPR TRAINING:** Students will complete *BLS/CPR for Healthcare Provider Training* as part of the EMT 151 course.

**Note:** *Students may not register themselves in EMT 151. Once students have submitted proof of the items listed above and the documents have been verified by the EMT Program Coordinator, the EMT department will register students internally. All students will be notified via email once they are accepted and registered in the EMT 151 Fall 2026 course.*
