## **Upward Bound**

### **Eligibility**

To be eligible for Upward Bound, you must be enrolled in the 9th - 12th grade at Astoria, Seaside or Warrenton High School and meet some of the following criteria:

- Have academic potential and demonstrate need for academic support
- Plan to attend college
- Meet federal low-income guidelines
- Be a potential first generation college student (neither parent has a 4-year degree)
- Be committed to participate in all aspects of the UB program.

### **How to Apply**
