Carol P. Schwartz Fund	<p>The purpose of the <i>Carol P. Schwartz Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, and all educational supplies to a student who has <u>met the admission requirements</u> and <u>is accepted into the Clatsop Community College Nursing program</u>. Minimum 3.5 GPA at time of application, and each term scholarship is in effect. Preference given to students graduating from Ilwaco, Naselle, or Astoria high schools. If no qualified candidates are graduates of these schools, preference will be given to students from Pacific county (WA) or Clatsop county (OR).</p>
Maritime Industry Helping Hand Scholarship (Peggy Haskell Family Memorial Fund)	<p>The purpose of the <i>Maritime Industry Helping Hand Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a CCC student pursuing a one-year certificate or two-year degree related to the Maritime Industry. Must be a registered CCC student admitted to a Maritime Industry-related degree or certificate program when scholarship is in effect. Must be half-time minimum (6 credits or more). Financial need is a consideration. Must maintain minimum 2.0 GPA while scholarship is in effect. Preference given to a first-generation student who is new to the maritime industry. May use scholarship funds for tuition, fees, required supplies, and books. After expenses paid, cash back to student. Must provide short answer to explain impact of scholarship for reaching maritime industry-related education and goals. Allotment disbursed equally between fall, winter, and spring terms.</p>
World of Speed	<p>The purpose of the <i>World of Speed Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, book and other educational expenses to <u>CCC students pursuing an AAS degree or a one-year certificate in the Automotive program</u>. In addition, the CCC Foundation will provide a basic tool kit and 2 work shirts. Student must be enrolled half-time or more (6 credits minimum). Minimum 2.5 GPA at time of application and each term scholarship is in effect. Student must write their answer to the question: "How will the World of Speed Scholarship help you achieve your career goals?" Cash back to student if educational expenses are paid in full.</p>

ESL/Adult Basic Education Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>ESL/Adult Basic Education Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, required supplies, and living expenses to registered Clatsop Community College students <u>admitted to a one-year certificate or a two-year degree program</u>. After educational expenses paid, cash back to student. Must demonstrate financial need. Must be currently enrolled in the <u>CCC Adult Basic Skills (ABS) program with regular attendance, OR have tested out of adult education</u>. Must submit a letter of recommendation from an ABE/ESL instructor or staff.</p> <p>Must maintain 2.0 GPA or higher each term the scholarship is in effect. Must be enrolled full or half-time (6 credits or more). Preference given to first generation college student, and student with English as a second language.</p>
Greg Dorcheus Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Greg Dorcheus Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>Clatsop Community College degree or certificate program students</u>. Must maintain 2.0 or higher in a minimum of 10 credits hours of CCC coursework at time of application and/or each term scholarship is in effect. Award to be distributed equally between fall, winter, and spring terms. Recipient may receive cash back after other educational expenses paid. Recipient is invited to provide a Thank You note to be shared with Greg Dorcheus.</p>
Healthcare Diversity Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Healthcare Diversity Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to Clatsop Community College students pursuing a certificate or degree related to healthcare. Minimum 2.0 GPA required at time of application and during each term scholarship is in effect. <u>Students are to participate in campus and community activities</u>. Must enroll for at least half-time (6 credits or more). Preference given to students from underrepresented racial and/or ethnic minorities; bilingual students; first-generation college students. Student may receive cash back after educational expenses are paid. Applicants will be selected by committee of DEI Council Committee members, and/or DEI Council Committee-selected members. Renewable each term.</p>
Lorraine Rodriguez Nursing Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Lorraine Rodriguez Nursing Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to Clatsop Community College Nursing students. <u>Student must have completed 45 credits towards a nursing degree</u>. Minimum 2.0 GPA required at time of application and during each term scholarship is in effect. Minimum enrollment of 6 credits each term. Preference given to: students from underrepresented racial and/or ethnic backgrounds; bilingual students; first generation college students. Student</p>

Sarah Shawa Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Sarah Shawa Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College students. Student must have completed FAFSA or ORSAA. Priority given to (in order): individuals from the Gaza strip, Shawa family members, or based on financial need.
Clatsop Care Center Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Clatsop Care Center scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to applicants working towards certification, licensure or degree in a field related to health care. Minimum enrollment requirement is half-time (no fewer than 6 quarter credits) .
Brenda Penner and Steve Forrester Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Brenda Penner and Steve Forrester Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to two <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing degree students. Financial need will be a consideration. Minimum 3.5 GPA . Must be registered full-time (12 or more credits) each term.
Chief Petty Officers Association Lower Columbia River Chapter Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Chief Warrant Officers Association Lower Columbia River Chapter Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, and supplies to a <u>Clatsop Community College student enrolled in a Maritime Science degree or certificate program</u> . Must be registered at least half-time each term (6 or more credits). Minimum 2.0 GPA (Students with no college credits may use their high school transcript to demonstrate GPA, or GED). Must submit written essay explaining goals and financial need. Preference given to veterans and active duty personnel, or their spouse or child.
Step to Success Career Tech Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Step to Success Career Tech Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>GED graduates</u> pursuing a Career/Technical Education (CTE) one-year certificate OR a two-year AAS degree at Clatsop Community College. Applicant must complete FAFSA. Must register full or half-time (6 credits or more) . Must maintain 2.5 or higher GPA while scholarship is in effect. Must submit one letter of recommendation, and written essay explaining goals and financial need .
Lum's Auto Center Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Lum's Auto Center Scholarship</i> is to provide tuition assistance to a Clatsop Community College Automotive Technology student pursuing a one-year certificate or a two-year AAS degree. Must be registered at CCC while scholarship is in effect. Minimum 2.0 GPA. Must be half-time (6 credits or more).

Allan and Marie Gann Maritime Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Allan and Marie Gann Maritime Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Maritime Science degree program students. Applicant must have completed FAFSA, and be a Maritime Science student. Minimum 3.0 GPA . Minimum enrollment half-time (6 or more credits) . Must have already completed 45 credits .
Beth Fassett Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Beth Fassett Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing degree program students. Financial need will be a consideration. Student must have completed FAFSA. Must be registered for 9 or more credits each term .
Evelyn Koppen Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Evelyn Koppen Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing degree program students. Financial need will be a consideration. Student must have completed FAFSA. Must be registered for 9 or more credits each term .
Marie Schultz Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Marie Schultz Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing degree program students. Financial need will be a consideration. Applicant must have completed the FAFSA, and be registered for at 9 or more credits each term .
Meredith Fick Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Meredith Fick Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing or other health-related/Allied Health degree program students with a minimum of 45 credits . Financial need will be a consideration. Student must have completed FAFSA. Must be registered full time (12 or more credits) . Minimum 2.0 GPA required at time of application and during time scholarship is in effect . Funds awarded Fall term.
Whitehead and Warwick Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Whitehead and Warwick Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for students pursuing nursing or other Allied Health programs. Student must have completed <u>one college-level science course</u> . Student must have completed a minimum of 10 credits, with a minimum 3.5 GPA . Must register for 9 or more credits each term . Preference given to: parents, veterans, current military personnel, or non-traditional students.

Nehalem Bay Emergency Services Scholarship	The purpose of the Nehalem Bay Scholarship is to provide financial assistance for registered CCC students enrolled in the Criminal Justice, Fire Sciences, or EMS programs. Must be registered half-time (6 credits or more) each term. Minimum 3.0 GPA.
Allyn Washington Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Allyn Washington Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or educational expenses to a <u>Clatsop Community College student pursuing a transfer degree. Student must be pursuing an Associate of Science Oregon Transfer Degree in : Computer Science, or an AAOT in Engineering, Chemistry, Mathematics, or Physics.</u> Must plan on pursuing a baccalaureate degree at an accredited four-year college or university. Minimum 3.0 GPA at time of application and while scholarship is in effect (students with no college credit may use their high school transcript to demonstrate a 3.0 GPA, or GED). Must be enrolled full-time (12 or more credits). Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from a full-time CCC faculty member; or if an incoming student from high school, a letter from a high school math or science teacher. Applicant must submit a written essay explaining their goals, and plans to transfer to a university.
CCC Visual Art Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>CCC Visual Art Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to students in their study of Visual Art at CCC. The visual arts are art forms such as painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics, photography, video, filmmaking, design, crafts and architecture. Must be registered full-time (12 credits or more). Minimum 2..5 GPA.
Laurie Choate Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Laurie Choate Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to a Clatsop Community College Nursing degree student. <u>Applicant must be enrolled in the CCC Nursing program, and pursuing a CCC nursing degree.</u> Minimum 2.7 GPA. Must submit one letter of recommendation, and a written essay explaining financial need and educational goals.
Providence Seaside Hospital Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Providence Seaside Hospital Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>two</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing degree students. Financial need will be a consideration. Funds will be disbursed in fall term. Applicant <u>must be accepted into CCC Nursing program,</u> and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Must be full-time each term (12 credits or more).

Columbia Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Columbia Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing degree students. Financial need will be a consideration. Applicant must have completed the FAFSA, and be registered for 9 or more credits each term.
Barbara Emily Knudson Foundation Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Barbara Emily Knudson Foundation Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for a <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College student who has established financial need and successfully completed one year at a community college level with a minimum of 45 credits ; be a single parent, or displaced worker enrolled or enrolling in a program directed to change career, or a non-traditional student. Student <u>must be an Oregon resident</u> , and have completed the FAFSA. Must be registered full-time (12 credits or more) . Minimum 2.0 GPA . Funds may be used for all educational expenses. Allotment will be disbursed equally between fall and winter terms after enrollment and verification of requisite GPA.
Columbia Memorial Hospital Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Columbia Memorial Hospital Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to <u>second-year</u> Clatsop Community College Nursing degree students. Scholarship is not need-based. Must be registered for 9 or more credits each term . Minimum 2.0 GPA at time of application, and during each term scholarship is in effect.
Funland Entertainment Center Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Funland Entertainment Center Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or other educational expenses to Clatsop Community College <u>degree-seeking or certificate program students</u> . Applicant must have completed the FAFSA. Must be registered full-time (12 credits or more) each term . Minimum 2.5 GPA . Scholarship recipients selected by merit/academic achievement and financial need. All students are encouraged to apply. Preference given to current/former employees of Funland Entertainment Center, Finn's, Fishhawk, Twisted Fish Steakhouse, Gearhart Book, Gearhart or Seaside Fultano's, Sign One, Times Theater, Sisu Brewing Co., Seaside Skooters, Fascination.
Historic Preservation Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Historic Preservation Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a student enrolled in their <u>second year</u> of the AAS in Historic Preservation program, with a minimum of 30 credits earned at time of application. Minimum 2.0 GPA at time of application. Must be enrolled full-time (12 credits or more) . Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, and all educational expenses.

Mary Wood Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Mary Wood Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a <u>CCC GED graduate</u> (or who will be a CCC GED graduate by June 30 prior to award year). Applicant must be admitted to CCC at time of application. Student must have financial need (completed FAFSA). Minimum enrollment half-time (6 credits or more) each term scholarship is in effect. Funds may be used for all educational expenses. Recipient will be announced at the CCC GED graduation ceremony.
Latino Club Annual Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Latino Club Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a student who is an <u>active member of the CCC Latino Club</u> at the time of application. Student must have attended a Latino Club sponsored event in the past 2 years. Minimum 2.0 GPA. Must be registered for a minimum of 3 credits.
Latino Club- High School Annual Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Latino Club High School Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a student who attended a CCC Latino Club event at Clatsop Community College in the past two years. Student <u>must have graduated from a Clatsop county high school the year prior</u> . Must be registered at CCC while scholarship is in effect. Minimum enrollment 3 credits. Minimum 2.0 GPA.
Dr. John & Mrs. Jan Swanson Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Dr. John and Mrs. Jan Swanson Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a degree-seeking student beginning in the fall term of their <u>second year</u> . Student must have completed at least 45 credits . Based on merit and academic achievement, goals, and financial need. Must have completed FAFSA. Must be registered half time (6 credit minimum). Minimum 3.0 GPA. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, or books. No cash back.
Arthur Fertig Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Arthur Fertig Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for a newly admitted student in fall term. <u>Can be a non-traditional student or recent high school graduate. Scholarship for a student with no prior post-high school training, a first time college student.</u> Preference for: Clatsop Community College district residents. Financial need is a consideration; must express some realistic educational goals. Must have completed FAFSA. Must be registered at least half-time (6 credits or more) . Funds can be used on tuition and fees. No cash back.

Scholarship Name	Description
Raven Scholarship	The purpose of the Raven Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a CCC student pursuing a <u>one-year certificate or a two-year degree</u> . Preference is given to nursing degree students. Student is dual enrolled in CCC Adult Basic Skills (ABS) program with regular attendance, or has graduated from the CCC ABS program. Student must also be enrolled in ESL (English as Second Language) program, or have completed the training. Student must be a registered degree-seeking student at time scholarship is in effect. Minimum enrollment is half-time (6 credits or more) . May use scholarship for all educational expenses.
Emmett D. Towler Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Emmett D. Towler Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to students enrolled in the areas of creative writing (Poetry, Drama, Fiction, Children’s Books), journalism, art and music. Scholars <u>do NOT have to major in the above disciplines</u> , yet they must demonstrate ability in these academic areas. Student <u>must submit a portfolio</u> of their creative work. Must be registered full-time (12 credits or more) each term. Minimum 2.5 GPA.
James Hill Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>James Hill Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a Clatsop County high school graduate planning to attain a <u>two or four-year degree in biology, fish or wildlife sciences</u> . Student must attend Clatsop Community College, and be registered full time each term (12 credits or more) .
Sue Richardson Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Sue Richardson Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to students majoring in <u>one or more of the following disciplines</u> (in order of importance): Math Education, Math, Education, Physics, Other Science (excluding Nursing). Preference for: Single parents, women, students over the age of 30. Must be registered half time (6 credit minimum). Minimum 2.5 GPA.
Amelia Kuitert Memorial Endowment Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Amelia Kuitert Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a student <u>majoring in a science</u> (biological, chemical, physical, computing, nursing, math, engineering; or pre-professional for medicine, dentistry or veterinary). It will be based on merit, with financial need as tied-breaker. Student must have completed FAFSA, and be registered full-time (12 credits or more) . Funds can be used for tuition, books, or cash to student.
CCC Foundation Fund Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>CCC Foundation Fund Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for a <u>new or continuing CCC student</u> . Funds can be used for tuition, fees, books, supplies or cash to student. Must be registered half-time (6 or more credits). Minimum 2.5 GPA.

Scholarship Name	Description
CCC Foundation Opportunity Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>CCC Foundation Opportunity Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to <u>current CCC students who could not file a FAFSA</u> ; financial need for educational costs not met by other financial aid or family support, excluding loans (will be verified by CCC Financial Aid Office). <u>Must have completed at least 18 credits before fall term</u> ; preference for students within 18 credits of graduating. Student must be registered half-time (6 credits or more) each term. Minimum 2.0 GPA. Funds can be used for all educational expenses. No cash back to student.
Chet & Edie Hogan Teaching Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Chet & Edie Hogan Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a <u>degree or certificate seeking student</u> . Preference is for a second year student (must have completed a minimum of 45 credits), with an interest in education or teaching. Minimum 2.5 GPA. Must be full time (12 credits or more). Funds can be used for tuition, fees, or books. No cash back.
Dwight T. Holland Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Dwight T. Holland Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a <u>CCC degree or certificate seeking student</u> . Student must have completed the FAFSA. Minimum 2.0 GPA. Must be enrolled at least half-time (6-8 credits) each term.
Judy Hogan Scholarship for the Arts	The purpose of the <i>Judy Hogan Scholarship for the Arts</i> is to provide financial assistance to a student with a <u>demonstrated interest in the visual arts and who is pursuing a degree in art</u> . Preference for: students studying 3D, visual art. Portfolio useful but not required. Based on financial need and academic achievement; Likelihood of success in art career, art institute, or BA are factors. Must have completed FAFSA. Must be registered half time (6 or more credits). Minimum 2.0 GPA. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, books, or supplies.
Megan Samuel Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Megan Samuel Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for <u>degree or certificate-seeking students</u> with demonstrated financial need. Student must have completed FAFSA. Minimum 2.5 GPA. Must be registered full-time (12 credits or more). Funds can be used for tuition, fees or books.
Memorial Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a <u>new or continuing CCC student</u> . Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Must register at least half-time (6 or more credits).
Merriam Shawa Nursing Scholarship	The purpose of the <i>Merriam Shawa Nursing Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a <u>second-year nursing student</u> . Must register for 9 or more credits. Minimum 3.0 GPA. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, books, or supplies.

Michael Ferguson Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Michael Ferguson Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for a <u>non-traditional student who will not be entering CCC directly from high school</u>.</p> <p>Preference for: Financial need, single parents, full-time students, students not entering directly from high school, and students working toward a specific educational goal or making satisfactory academic progress.</p> <p>Must have completed FAFSA. Must be registered full time (12 credit minimum). Funds can be used toward all educational expenses, <u>including childcare</u>. May receive cash back for living expenses.</p>
Rochester Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Rochester Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to <u>students who are ineligible for FAFSA or traditional financial aid</u>. Based on financial need. Emergency student loans on an expedited basis. Must be registered half time (6 credits or more). Minimum 2.5 GPA.</p>
Sally and Nestor Leino Memorial Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Sally and Nestor Leino Memorial Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a <u>CCC student seeking a degree or certificate</u>. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Must register for at least 9 credits each term. Funds can be used for tuition, books or supplies.</p>
Steven Mund Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Steven Mund Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to <u>graduates of Clatsop County high schools. Can be a first-time CCC student</u>. Applicant must be half-time each term (6 credits or more). Minimum 3.0 GPA.</p>
Warfield & Elizabeth Martin Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Warfield & Elizabeth Martin Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to a <u>second-year CCC student with career plans in education/teaching</u>. Based on merit and academic achievement, goals and references, and financial need. Must be registered full time (12 credit minimum). Minimum 3.0 GPA. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, or books. No cash back.</p>
Arline and Cliff LaMear Annual Scholarship	<p>The purpose of the <i>Arline and Cliff LaMear Annual Scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance to registered CCC students who are <u>enrolled in a certificate or degree-seeking program</u>. Funds can be used for tuition, fees, books, supplies and/or any educational expense such as childcare and transportation. Recipient may receive cash back. Student may be full or part-time (6 credits or more). Preference given to first generation college student. FAFSA application is not required. Must maintain 2.5 GPA or higher.</p>
Chopping Scholarship Fund	<p>The purpose of the <i>Margaret Chopping scholarship</i> is to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees and books for <u>two years</u> to two students <u>planning to enter or already enrolled in the CCC Nursing program</u> in fall term of the award year. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA at time of application and while scholarship is in effect. Must be enrolled full-time (12 credits or more).</p>
